"Contemporary Electricity Distribution Networks - HEDNO" Vocational Master in partnership with the University of Western Macedonia

In response to the contemporary training trends and the demand for specialized knowledge resulting from the rapid transformation and modernization of the company, HEDNO announces the establishment of a Vocational Master Program.

Demonstrating its commitment to innovation and following the provisions of the new institutional framework, HEDNO interconnects the labor market with the scientific community and creates the Master's Program "Contemporary Electricity Distribution Networks – HEDNO" in partnership with the University of Western Macedonia.

The program's goal is to provide targeted, specialized training for the executives of HEDNO to enhance their knowledge, in harmony with today's requirements.

The duration of the program, which leads to the award of a recognized Postgraduate Diploma, is set at 14 months and includes the preparation of a Dissertation. Participants must physically attend the courses and workshops which will be held every 2 weeks at the facilities of the University of Western Macedonia, and at the schools of the HEDNO (Anixi, Attica & Florina).

40 executive members of HEDNO will attend the 1st Cycle of the Postgraduate Program (in total 2 Cycles). As part of the Company's Corporate Social Responsibility, 15 places (max.) are available for Graduates who are not employed at HEDNO. Tuition fees and accommodation & travel expenses for 10 out of the 15 places are covered by HEDNO. Tuition, travel and accommodation expenses for all other 5 places, shall be covered by the students.
