New, Modern Electricity Distribution Center in Agios Dimitrios, Attica

A very important project for the residents of Agios Dimitrios, Attica, is moving into the implementation phase, as HEDNO is proceeding with the preliminary studies for the new Electricity Distribution Center.

More specifically, the project, with a total budget of approximately €31 million, is expected to radically transform the area and upgrade the quality of life and daily experience of its residents. In the area where the new Distribution Center will be built, replacing the existing outdoor facilities, the space will also undergo redevelopment with the aim of a high-aesthetic enhancement. Upon completion of the new Distribution Center, all existing outdoor installations will be removed and a green core will be created within the urban space.

At the same time, this project will cover the energy needs of the Municipality and the surrounding areas, strengthening the reliability of the Distribution Network and providing improved services to citizens.

The new, modern Distribution Centers constructed by HEDNO within urban areas across Greece operate with full safety protocols and advanced automation technologies, and they contribute to the energy, economic, and aesthetic upgrade of the areas in which they are installed.

It is noted that Distribution Centers are facilities where equipment is installed exclusively indoors, designed to step down high-voltage electricity to medium voltage, which is then distributed to the wider area through an underground network.

In the context of initiating this important project, CEO Mr. Anastasios Manos met with Mayor Stelios Mamallakis and emphasized: "HEDNO is committed to



modernizing and upgrading the electricity distribution network nationwide, with the aim of providing improved services to all citizens. Projects like this bring us closer to achieving our goal."

Mayor Mr. S. Mamallakis, for his part, highlighted: "The upgrading of the substation is a very important project that significantly contributes to the safety, health, and quality of life of the residents of our city."
