Safety instructions for kite flying

The Hellenic Electricity Distribution Network Operator (HEDNO) advises you not to fly your kite near power lines, as there is serious risk of electric shock to you and power outages in the surrounding area.

If your kite becomes entangled in the lines, for your safety:

1. Do not attempt to free it by pulling the string or by using other objects, including wooden objects
2. Do not attempt to climb electricity distribution poles or street-lighting poles, nor go to locations close to live power lines.
