HEDNO: Free LED Bulbs for vulnerable households in border areas

HEDNO is offering free, state-of-the-art, highly energy-efficient LED bulbs to vulnerable households in border areas, providing practical support while encouraging the adoption of practices that contribute to the efficient use of energy.

The initiative will initially be rolled out in Western and Eastern Macedonia, Thrace and the islands of the Northeastern Aegean.

More specifically, from **1 September to 31 December 2026**, HEDNO will provide a free pack of six LED bulbs to beneficiaries of the Social Residential Tariff (SRT) residing in these areas.

The initiative combines social support with the promotion of energy savings, as the use of LED bulbs helps reduce both electricity consumption and household energy costs.

The initiative forms part of HEDNO's ongoing commitment to implementing actions with a positive social and environmental impact, while also contributing to national and European efforts to improve energy efficiency and achieve a sustainable energy transition.

Beneficiaries of the Social Residential Tariff (SRT) residing in Western and Eastern Macedonia, Thrace and the islands of the Northeastern Aegean will be able to collect their free pack of six LED bulbs from their local HEDNO offices, between 08:00 and 14:00.

The following documents are required for collection:

- Identity card or other identification document
- A recent electricity bill



Through initiatives such as this, HEDNO supports local communities, particularly vulnerable social groups, combining social responsibility with energy efficiency and environmental protection.
